

Sign up by this Sunday, January 28! Lent begins this year on Ash Wednesday, February 14. Lent isn't only about sacrificially giving up something. It's also about adding something to your spiritual walk. Join us to explore our risk-taking Jesus through worship services, Lenten reflections and a fascinating Lenten book study, based on the book *Entering the Passion of Jesus*, by Dr. Amy-Jill Levine. You have two options to attend the book study. Wednesdays, February 14 - March 20, in Youth Range from 2:00-3:30 pm (led by Pastor Leslie, in-person and on Zoom). Mondays, February 19 - March 25, in Youth Range from 6:00-7:30 pm (led by Ann Kessler, in-person only). GUATEMALA MISSION TRIP IN NEED OF FUNDS

Pura Vida has worked for a period of 20 years in the country of Guatemala. In addition to their work in the fields of education and health, more than 2,000 volunteers from 40 states have helped to build adobe and cinder block homes for 49 families who were in extreme need of safe housing. These volunteers also helped in the construction of classrooms at Caserio Rosario and San Jose Pacho schools. Over 14 churches / organizations were represented with FUMC being prominent among them. We are headed to Guatemala on February 8-17 to build again and we are in need of approximately \$1,300 to completely fund this effort. 


WINTER MISSION U: FINDING AND BUILDING PEACE IN AN ANXIOUS WORLD

ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY

Should we ever have a Sunday with extreme inclement weather and feel it's best to cancel the worship service, an e-news update will be sent out by 8:00am on Sunday morning. DID YOU KNOW?


There are numerous access codes registered to our access control system. Our access codes are intentionally not valid 24/7/365 as is considered best practice by the Protecting Houses of Worship seminars put on by the FBI, state, county, and local authorities. The access control system keeps track of when each access code is scheduled to be valid and at which entry. Especially over the Holidays, the access control system declined entry to many using access codes when they were not scheduled to be valid. It's up to group leaders, committee chairs, etc. to fill out building use and access paperwork so that meetings, events, etc. can be properly scheduled. Paperwork for outside groups must be renewed annually. If you can't get in with an access code, first talk to your group leader or committee chair.
