We look forward to many years of collaboration with Loveland Preschool. Research shows that there is a "preschool desert" in Loveland. Loveland Preschool has lovingly fulfilled a great need in the community for 60



years. It is our shared mission to serve the families of the Loveland community and provide children a safe space to grow, learn and thrive. Having LPS sharing our sacred space will also spark new life for the ministries and missions of the church, it will convey a vibrancy and energy at our church to our neighbors, and it will introduce young families to the warmth and Christ-centered care evident at FUMC. The project is currently under review by the Mountain Sky Conference's District Board of Church Location & Building.
