NOTES FROM THE TRUSTEES

Hello church family, this is Debbie Tikka, the chair of the Trustees Committee. I want to explain a little bit about what has been happening with the main elevator (the one next to the sanctuary). Since about Christmas there have been some issues with it running properly. We have a new technician who has been addressing the problems and getting them fixed as these issues come about. I understand that this seems like "putting a band-aid" on the situation and has caused some major concerns of the safety of this elevator. Please understand that this is an old system and parts are becoming obsolete, but it is our best solution right now to keep the church in ADA compliance until we can get the elevator a modernized upgrade. (The upgrade for just this one elevator can cost up to \$100,000, or more.) Rest assured, I have been doing everything I can, as well as the technician, to keep the elevator running safely. If you have any questions or concerns do not hesitate to come and talk to me. I will be more than happy to explain everything in greater detail.



I also want to give a big shout out to Mike and Larry Carlson. They donated new windows to be put into the four doors at the West side entry to Coy Hall. These were done on Tuesday, February 25 and they look fabulous. The old windows were plexiglass, and they were replaced with a tempered window and are a lot clearer now. Thank you, Mike and Larry, for this wonderful donation!
