## Discussion

Continued conversation from Coy Hall ~ Joy moved, John M seconded: Approve the bid of \$6975 to
Proclaim Audio and Video for one TV and Screen Cast in Coy Hall pending Trustees' approval. Question:
Where will the money come from? Answer: For now, from the 57<sup>th</sup> St funds. In July 2026, money will be
moved from the Foundation to reimburse those funds. Motion passed unanimously.

- Facility Use Committee
  - o Barry moved, Cindy seconded: Approve replacing the window in the space above the sanctuary with safety glass from Handiglass at the cost of ~\$1000 pending Trustees' approval. Motion passed unanimously.
  - o Cindy moved, John K seconded: Approve upgrades to our internet at the cost of ~\$1000 pending Trustees' approval. Motion passed unanimously. (The preschool is willing to get their own internet, but we will allow them to use ours, and they use very little.)
  - o Joy led discussion on the renaming of spaces in the building to reflect our commitment as a place of worship and a place of outreach ministry. Joy moved that Council approve the names that the Facility Use Committee agreed upon with the exception of the basement floor of the previous education wing. (The document addressing the names is attached with the minutes.) Comments included: the FUC has done a LOT of work; some of the names sound a little 'cutesy,' would the name 'Pacemaker' offend some folks?; 'Pulse Point' is what the local emergency dispatch uses. After much discussion, the motion passed unanimously.
  - o The new website will include facility use information.
- Policies and education needed for protocols in case ICE shows up at the church ~ Safety and Security
   There is some urgency in addressing this issue. Judy, Andrea, Matt and Carolyn Bouchard will
   work on this with assistance from Safety & Security.
- Bishop Kristin Stoneking will visit and preach at a combined FUMC/TUMC service August 31st. Worship will be at TUMC (hopefully streamed to FUMC), and the reception will be at FUMC.
